The impugned order affects the licensee M/s Radha Krishan Shri Niwas, which is not before us as an entity and rather this petition has been filed by individuals who are co-sharers in the land. We are of the opinion that since the order affects the firm M/s Radha Krishan Shri Niwas, the petition should have been prosecuted by it. The petitioners obviously cannot have a grievance against the impugned order which affects the firm and has been passed on account of the firm's default in not providing relevant details as solicited by the Committee.

The petition is dismissed.

However, the petitioners would be at liberty to approach the Committee with the grievance that they have set out in the petition. If permissible in law, the Committee may look into it.
