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On 09.07.2018, on behalf of the appellants statement was made to accept ₹2,35,000/- over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. Today, on behalf of respondent Nos.3 and 4 i.e. ICICI Lombard General Insurance Company Limited and Reliance General Insurance Company Limited, concurrence has been given to this effect. Thus, a sum of ₹2,35,000/- (₹ Two Lac Thirty Five Thousand Only) is allowed to the appellants against respondent Nos.3 and 4 - Insurance Companies. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellants, the enhanced amount be paid to appellant No.2 – Aasiya wife of Shabbir.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to respondent Nos.3 and 4 - Insurance Companies to deposit crossed – cheque for ₹1,17,500/- each i.e. 50% of their respective shares (in total ₹2,35,000/-) in the name of appellant No.2 – Aasiya wife of Shabbir with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 01.09.2018, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheque to learned counsel/representative of the respondent – Insurance Company. The appellant(s)' counsel/appellant(s) may collect the cheques

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from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and
file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
