Petitioner has filed the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 3(1)(b) of Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1988 for directing the respondent to release him on parole.

Petitioner is undergoing sentence in FIR No.126 dated 30.07.2009 under Sections 363, 366-A, 376(2), 377, 302, 34 of Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Nangal Chaudhary, District Mahendragarh. Petitioner sought the instructions that respondent No.2-Jail Superintendent of Police, Jhajjar, District Jail, Jhajjar, Haryana should be directed to decide the application dated 04.09.2018 (Annexure P-1) for grant of parole in a time bound manner.

Written statement of Anil Kumar, Deputy Superintendent, District

Jail, Jhajjar on behalf of respondents No.1 & 2 along with Annexure R-1 has been filed and taken on record.

State in reply has stated that no such application was ever received .

It being so, petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to move an application before the Jail Superintendent of Police, Jhajjar, District Jail, Jhajjar, Haryana who shall accept the same and decide the same in the time frame as fixed by the instructions of Government of Haryana.
