This petition is filed for setting aside the award of the MACT, Hisar, which has been passed in the National Lok Adalat, which was held on 9.9.2017 on the basis of compromise entered into between the parties. The petitioner has submitted that no compromise was effected whereas the parties had suffered the statement before Lok Adalat, which is also appended with this petition at page No.41, in which it is mentioned that “*we, the undersigned have entered into settlement under the auspice of Lok Adalat and have mutually agreed that the decision/award be rendered on the following lines*”. As per the aforesaid compromise a sum of ₹13,50,000/- was agreed upon as compensation towards full and final settlement of the claim set up by the claimants.

In view of the aforesaid, I do not agree with the petitioners that they had not agreed to take ₹13,50,000/- towards compensation and the award passed by the Lok Adalat is without any compromise.

With these observations, the present petition is found to be without any merit and the same is hereby dismissed.
