The petitioner had failed in the subject of American Literature in the final examination of the MA (English). He applied for re-evaluation and the fresh result has been declared. He has passed in American Literature. Submits that the re-evaluation result relates back to the main examination, and therefore, the petitioner will be deemed to be a pass candidate having secured in both the academic years a total of 570 out of 1000 marks. Detailed marks card dated 31st August, 2016 is Annex. P-6. Interviews are yet to be conducted. The petitioner apprehends that his candidature would not be considered by treating him as having failed in the subject of American Literature as per the detailed marks card submitted alongwith the application for the post of Post Graduate Teacher HES-II (Group-B) (English).

The writ petition is premature because no adverse order has been passed. However, to allay the apprehension of the petitioner, a direction is issued

Md. Firoz Khan to the respondent-Commission to take up the petitioner's representation dated 2018.02.15 09:37

16th January, 2018 (Annex. P-8) and decide the same within three days from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. Upon which decision, in case favourable, the petitioner will be called for interview.
