Concededly, the petitioners were employed with the respondent-department as Helpers. Their employment was contractual in nature. Concededly, their services were dispensed with on 16.03.2017, and therefore, they are no longer in service of the respondents. In these circumstances, the relief prayed for in this petition is mis-conceived as the petitioners shall first have to assail their termination, for, which they could always raise an industrial dispute under Section 2-A of the Industrial Dispute Act, 1947.

Thus, no ground is made out to interfere in exercise of extraordinary jurisdiction under Article 226 of the Constitution of India. The petition is accordingly, dismissed.
