Counsel for the State submits that the present petition has been rendered infructuous as it was a challenge to the order of suspension of the petitioner and after holding of a regular enquiry against the petitioner by the Sub-Divisional Officer (Civil), Hisar, a report has been submitted, which has been duly considered by the Deputy Commissioner-cum-District Election Officer (Panchayat), Haryana and subsequently, an order of removal of the petitioner has been passed by the Competent Authority on 15.05.2018.

Keeping in view the above fact, it is apparent that the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous and this explains the non-appearance of the counsel for the petitioner on 16.05.2018 and thereafter, today.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous. Liberty is, however, granted to the petitioner to revive the present contempt petition in case the submission made by the counsel for the State is found to be incorrect.
