The petitioners are apprehending that they may be removed by the authorities without affording any opportunity of hearing. Only on the basis of apprehension that before passing of any adverse order against the petitioners, they would not be heard by the respondents authorities, the present petition has been filed. There is no document on record to show that any adverse order has been passed or the respondents authorities are likely to pass any order under the facts and circumstances of the case.

Before passing any adverse order, affording an opportunity of hearing is the requirement of law. No direction is required to be issued.

It is expected that in case, any action is to be taken, the respondents authorities would adopt the process of law.

The present petition is dismissed as pre-mature.
