Present appeal has been preferred against award dated 24.12.2014 passed by Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Bathinda (for short,'the Tribunal').

Ketak Sharma lost his life in a motor vehicular accident that occurred on 26.02.2012. The legal heirs of the deceased filed a claim petition under Section 163-A of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (for short,'the Act'). The Tribunal awarded a sum of Rs.3,80,000/- along with interest @9% per annum.

The present appeal has been filed for enhancement. The Tribunal has calculated the compensation amount in accordance with IInd Schedule appended to the Act. Even an amount of Rs.20,000/- has been awarded under conventional heads.

Learned counsel for the appellant was not in a position to show any ground for interference in the said award.

The appeal is dismissed having no merit.
