AJAY KUMAR MITTAL, J. (Oral)

1. The prayer in this petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus or any other appropriate writ to cease/stay the large scale construction going on after the illegal demolition of the slum cluster, namely, Jain Dera, Village Lakkarpur, Surajkund, Faridabad, Haryana along with status quo ante as on or before 21.04.2017 and also to direct the respondents to rehabilitate or provide alternate accommodation to the owners of the demolished houses/jhuggies of slum cluster.

2. After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that he may be allowed to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to approach the Civil Court seeking redressal of the grievance as raised in the present writ petition as certain facts are required to be established.

3. It has been noticed that the petitioner had earlier approached this Court by way of Civil Writ Petition No.1437 of 2018 which was dismissed as withdrawn on 24.01.2018 on the statement of learned counsel for the petitioner that certain factual matrix was required to be established for which liberty was claimed to approach appropriate authority in accordance with law. Therefore, the second writ petition would not be maintainable.

4. Dismissed as withdrawn.

5. It shall, however, be open to the petitioner to approach the Civil Court for redressal of his grievance, in accordance with law.
