This petition is filed against the award dated 11.5.2017 passed by the Permanent Lok Adalat (Public Utility Services), SAS Nagar, Mohali [for short 'the PLA'] by which the application filed the petitioner under Section 22-C of the Legal Services Authorities Act, 1987 [for short 'the Act'] has been dismissed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that though the petitioner had stated on an affidavit dated 5.12.2012 that he would be bound to accept the report of the laboratory even in his absence but the electricity department has not explain to him as to how he is liable to pay the amount which he has been asked for.

I have heard learned counsel for the petitioner and after taking into account the finding recorded by the PLA in para No.12 of the impugned order, I do not find any reason to interfere in this petition and the same is hereby dismissed.
