The grievance raised before us is that though an appeal has been preferred by the present petitioner against the order of the Asstt. Collector on 30.08.2017 along with a prayer for stay but the same has not been decided. The matter is now slated for 30.03.2018.

It is contended that in this interregnum when the appeal is pending, an order has been passed to demolish the construction and a Duty Magistrate appointed for the purpose.

After hearing the learned counsel for the petitioner, we deem it appropriate to dispose of the instant petition with a direction that the competent authority hearing the appeal shall consider the matter regarding stay on 30.03.2018 and dispose of the prayer by passing appropriate orders. If for some reason the appeal cannot be disposed of or the application cannot be heard on 30.03.2018, the same shall positively be heard within a period of four weeks

thereafter and till that time status quo with regard to possession shall be maintained. Ordered accordingly.
