The present appeal directs challenge against award dated 02.01.2015 passed by the Motor Accidents Claims Tribunal, Fatehgarh Sahib whereby compensation has been awarded on account of death of Karnail Singh in a motor vehicular accident that took place on 16.08.2012.

Counsel for the appellant-insurance company would inform that the appeal has been preferred by the insurance company only to assail findings of the Tribunal on issue No.3 pertaining to driving licence of Jaswinder Singh, driver of the offending vehicle car bearing No.CH-03-U-8916.

Counsel is fair enough to concede that the controversy with regard to driving licence no longer subsists in view of the judgment of Hon'ble the Supreme Court **Mukund Dewangan vs. Oriental Insurance Company Limited 2017(7) Scale 731.**

In view of the above, the appeal stands disposed of.
