By way of filing the present civil writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India read with Section 3 (1) (b) of Prisoner Good Conduct (Release) Act the petitioner prays for grant of emergency parole for 10 days on account of wedding of the nephew, Shubham (Goppi) scheduled to be held in Naggal Khera, Dharamshalla, Kurali, District Mohali (Punjab) from 19.02.2018 to 21.02.2018. The petitioner was convicted under Section 409 IPC in FIR No. 121 dated 06.7.2005 registered at Police Station GRP Ambala Cantt, Ambala undergoing imprisonment for two years, presently confined in Central Jail, Ambala.

According to the petitioner, he is the elder one in the family and is necessary to join the marriage ceremony. The son of the petitioner submitted a representation to the Superintendent of Jail, Ambala with a recommendation from Sarpanch Gram Panchayat

Sambhalkha, Block Saha District Ambala but the authorities refused to accept the same and, therefore, the petitioner filed the present petition.

I have heard counsel for the parties.

The petitioner Kiran Pal S/o Hukam Singh R/o VPO Sambhalkha, Tehsil Saha, District Ambala is ordered to be released on parole from 18.02.2018 (morning) till 24.02.2018 (morning) subject to his furnishing personal and surety bond to the satisfaction of the Superintendent, Central Jail, Ambala. The period of 6 days of parole shall begin after the personal and surety bonds furnished by the petitioner are accepted. On expiry of 06 days i.e. from 18.02.2018 (morning) till 24.02.2018 (morning) of parole, the petitioner would surrender at gate of Central Jail, Ambala.

In that way, the petition stands disposed of.

Custody certificate filed in Court is taken on record.
