Vide order dated 11.7.2018 on the basis of statement made by learned counsel for the appellant a proposal was made for enhancing compensation by ₹ 6,50,000/- over and above the amount already granted by the MACT concerned. Today, learned counsel for the Insurance Company has stated that the Insurance Company has agreed to enhance the compensation only by ₹ 6,30,000/- and not by ₹ 6,50,000/- and has signed to that effect. Learned counsel for the appellant has agreed to this counter-offer of the respondent-Insurance Company.

Accordingly, ₹ 6,30,000/- (Rs. Six Lakh Thirty Thousand only) is allowed as further compensation over and above the compensation already awarded by the MACT. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellant the enhanced amount would be paid to Sh. Jai Bhagwan Dass (father of appellant-Amrit Lal @ Amrit Pal @ Amrit Kumar).

We dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque in the sum of ₹ 6,30,000/- in the name of **Sh. Jai Bhagwan Dass** (father of appellant-Amrit Lal @ Amrit Pal @ Amrit Kumar, he being unsound mind) with the office of the Lok Adalat of

the High Court on or before 17.12.2018 failing which the amount will carry 9% interest p.a. from the date of this order till the cheque is deposited with the office of the Lok Adalat. The appellant's counsel/appellant's father may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order/statement be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the High Court.
