The limited prayer of the petitioner, in the present petition, is for issuance of direction to respondent No.1 to decide the revision petition expeditiously in accordance with law and to maintain status quo till the revision petition is heard which is fixed for hearing on 07.03.2018. The application for stay has also been moved along with the revision petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is apprehending that respondent No.2 had obtained warrants of possession and a great prejudice would be caused to him, in case, the revision petition filed by him is not heard.

Keeping in view the limited prayer and also the fact that the revision petition is pending for 07.03.2018, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to hear the pending revision petition on the date already fixed i.e 07.03.2018 and in case, for any sufficient reason, the same is not heard on that day, it be heard within a period of two weeks thereafter.

Meanwhile, the parties are directed to maintain *status quo* till the disposal of the revision petition or application for interim stay.
