Aggrieved by the decree of divorce granted to the respondent-wife, the appellant-husband has preferred this appeal.

Vide order dated 20.05.2016, the appellant-husband was required to pay sum of Rs.20,000/- to the respondent-wife towards the interim litigation expenses. The amount has not been paid despite number of opportunities having been granted to the appellant. The appellant has been adopting evasive approach as no body appeared on behalf of the appellant on 19.01.2017 and later on 27.04.2017.

Today again nobody has put in appearance on behalf of the appellant to pay a sum of Rs.20,000/- towards interim litigation expenses. It appears that the appellant is not interested in contesting the decree of divorce granted to the respondent-wife.

Case called twice. No one has put in appearance on behalf of the appellant.

Dismissed for non-prosecution.
