Through the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of a writ especially in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant her family pension, along-with interest @ 18% per annum on account of death of her husband.

2. Though, in the instant petition notice of motion has already been issued by this Court on 27.03.2017 and in response to which respondents No.1 to 3 has already filed the reply. At this juncture, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondents No.2 & 3 to decide the representation dated 08.02.2017 (P-8) in a time bound manner, which is still pending with the respondents.

3. Without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in her representation dated 08.02.2017 (P-8) and to take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order considering all the facts narrated in the aforesaid representation and also in the light of judgment passed by Hon'ble Division Bench of this Court in CWP No. 2371 of 2010, titled as *Harbans Lal vs. State of Punjab and others; decided on 31.08.2010*, within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

4. However, if petitioner still feel aggrieved by any of the orders passed by the aforesaid authority, she shall be at liberty to have recourse to other remedies available under the law including to approach this Court.
