CWP No. 3625 of 2018

By virtue of instant petition preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant her family pension, along-with interest @18% per annum, on account of death of her husband.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though a representation dated October 11, 2017 (P-7) was moved to respondents No.2 and 3 but till date neither any reply has been received nor any action has been

taken. He further submits that he feels satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the afore-said representation (P-7) within a stipulated period.

3. Accordingly, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to consider and decide the representation dated October 11, 2017 (P-7) in accordance with law, rules, regulations and instructions issued by the Government from time to time within a period of three months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

4. However, in case petitioner still feels aggrieved by any order of the afore-said authority, she shall be at liberty to have recourse to other remedies available to her under law including to approach this Court.
