Prayer of the petitioner is that the Panchayat has no land to offer for constructing houses for the poor. Reference has been made to a letter of the Deputy Commissioner stating so.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, we are of the opinion that no interference is warranted. If the land is not available, the petitioner has a remedy of approaching the authorities to satisfy them in this regard in which eventuality they would be free to take recourse to other means available to them in law to construct the houses for the poor.

It is entirely upto the Gram Panchayat and Government authorities to sort out these issues and as a Court no orders can be passed that are obstructionist to a cause espousing welfare of the poor.

In view of above, instant petition is hereby dismissed leaving the petitioner to its remedies in law.
