Vide order dated 02.11.2017, on the basis of statement made by learned counsel for the appellants a proposal was made for enhancing compensation by ₹ 3,25,000/- over and above the amount already granted by the MACT concerned. Today, learned counsel for the Insurance Company has stated that the Insurance Company has agreed to enhance the compensation only by ₹ 3,00,000/- and not by ₹ 3,25,000/- and has signed to that effect. Learned counsel for the appellants has agreed to this counter-offer of the respondent-Insurance Company.

Accordingly, ₹ 3,00,000/- (Rs. Three lacs only) is allowed as further compensation over and above the compensation already awarded by the MACT.

We dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheques in the sum of ₹ 3,00,000/- in the name of appellant No.1 namely Jamaluddin son of Sh.Yasim, appellant No.2 namely Smt.Mogri wife of Mr. Jamaluddin and perform respondent No.4 namely Smt. Gulshan widow of Abbas, equally, with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or

before 16.03.2018, failing which the amount will carry 9% interest p.a. from the date of this order till the cheques are deposited with the office of the Lok Adalat. The appellant's counsel/appellants may collect the cheques from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order/statement be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the High Court.
