Present petition, filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeks direction to the official respondents to execute the warrant of possession on the basis of the Sanad Takseem dated 22.05.2013 (Annexure P-1) passed by respondent No.4, in the partition proceedings for the land measuring 7 kanals 8 marlas.

In the reply filed by Mr.Gurmit Singh, Assistant Collector, 1st Grade (Tehsildar), Sultanpur Lodhi, Distt Kapurthala, on behalf of respondents No.1, 4 to 6, in the Court today, it has been sought to be justified that due to the pendency of the litigation, possession could not be delivered. It has further been mentioned that possession now has been delivered on 25.07.2018.

Resultantly, in view of the above, it is apparent that the present petition has been rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of, accordingly.
