The petitioner is a convict, suffering sentence in a case registered vide FIR No.158 dated 1.8.2010 under Section 302 of the IPC and Section 27 of the Arms Act at Police Station City Dadri. He has prayed for parole for a period of four weeks, in terms of the provision of Section 3(1)(b) of The Haryana Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1988 [for short 'the Act'], for renovation of his house.

Before issuance of notice, this Court had asked the petitioner vide order dated 21.2.2018 to place on record latest photographs of the house to ascertain as to whether the house of the petitioner really requires renovation or not. The petitioner has filed CM No.4347 of 2018 for placing on record the photographs of the alleged house. The said application is allowed and the photographs are taken on record.

I have perused the photographs which pertains to a School called KIDZEE. The petitioner has not produced on record any photograph

of the house and has thus made a false prayer before Superintendent Jail, Jhajjar for parole that he wanted to renovate his house.

In this view of the matter, I am not inclined to grant any relief to the petitioner, who has not come to the Court with clean hands and hence, the present petition is hereby dismissed.
