This order will dispose of FAO Nos.4217 and 6691 of 2015 as these have emerged out of the award dated 01.12.2014 passed by the Motor Accidents Claims Tribunal, Rohtak whereby compensation has been assessed on account of death of Naveen Kumar in a motor vehicular accident that took place on 25.11.2012.

FAO No.4217 of 2015 has been filed by the National Insurance Co. Ltd. (in short 'the insurance company') whereas the other appeal has been preferred by the claimants seeking enhancement of compensation.

Counsel for the insurance company would apprise the Court that the appeal has been preferred to challenge quantum of compensation.

Counsel for the parties would state that they do not press the appeals for decision on merits and the same may be disposed of accordingly.
