The petitioner has approached this Court under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, by way of Public Interest Litigation (PIL), seeking direction to respondents No.1 & 2 i.e. Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) and the Directorate of School Education, to take steps and stop any commercial activity being carried out by the British School, respondent No.3 in its school as well as other schools indulging in commercial activities which is a clear violation of the CBSE Affiliation Bye-laws and notifications (Annexure P-1 collectively), issued by the CBSE from time to time. A further prayer for direction to respondents No.1 & 2 to constitute a committee which would regularly check up that the CBSE Affiliation Bye-laws are being properly followed by the schools affiliated with CBSE, has also been made.

2. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner states that inadvertently certain relevant facts and documents could not be incorporated in the writ petition. Accordingly, a prayer has been made for

withdrawal of writ petition with liberty to the petitioner to file a fresh one on the same cause of action by incorporating better and correct particulars.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty as prayed for.
