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**RAKESH KUMAR JAIN, J.**

This petition is filed under Section 3 (1) (aa) of the Punjab Good Conduct Prisoners (Temporary Release) Act, 1962 (for short 'the Act') for grant of parole for 4 weeks in order to attend his ailing mother and wife who are suffering from cancer.

The petitioner is a life convict, presently lodged in Central Jail, Amritsar. He had moved an application for seeking parole to the Superintendent, Central Jail, Amritsar, who after receiving the report from the SSP, Amritsar (Rural), refused to recommend the prayer of the petitioner for release on parole on the ground that the petitioner after coming out on parole, may cause harm to the complainant or his family.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the complainant's family lives two kilometers away from the house of the petitioner. He further submits that at the time of grant of parole, condition may be imposed that the petitioner would not visit the area in which the family of the complainant

resides or even to the shop of the complainant. However, the fact that since it is not denied by the respondent that the mother and wife of the petitioner, both are suffering from cancer, therefore, keeping in view their ill health, the present petition is hereby disposed of with a direction that the petitioner be released on parole for a period of 4 weeks on furnishing his bail bonds to the satisfaction of District Magistrate, Amritsar.

The petitioner shall surrender to the jail authorities on the day when the period of parole would come to an end and shall also maintain good conduct and behaviour.
