CM-14356-2018:

This is an application for placing on record short reply to the application under Order 1 Rule 10 CPC. Application is allowed as prayed for. Reply is taken on record. Registry to page mark the paper book accordingly.

CWP-3915-2018:

Grievance of the petitioners is that they are being asked to pay tariff in respect of off-loading of gypsum from the Hydraulic Tippers, for which no labour is required. According to petitioners, about 80 Tippers cross the border every day with cargo of gypsum. They are thereafter automatically operated and gypsum is off-loaded. Yet Central Warehousing Corporation has taken a decision to charge labour tariff on the same.

At the outset, Mr. Singla submits that the matter shall be looked into by respondent No.2, which is the appropriate authority for the purpose and a fresh decision shall be taken within two months.

In view of statement made on behalf of respondent No.2, no further direction is necessary. The petition is hereby disposed of.

An application has already been moved by a labour union for its impleadment, as they are directly affected in the matter. However, as they have been heard, there is no necessity of passing any specific order in the application moved by them.
