This appeal has been filed against the order of the Additional Sessions Judge, Gurdaspur dated 3.11.2015 dismissing the objections filed under Section 34 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 by the appellant.

The only ground taken by the appellant before the Court below was that it had not been served. The Court found that the registered notice issued to the appellant at the address which it had itself furnished was returned back with the report of refusal. Thereafter, another notice was sent and a copy thereof was pasted on the gate of the premises of the appellant. It was for this reason that the Court below held that the appellant was duly served and consequently refused to interfere on the ground of non service.

Counsel for the appellant has not been able to show how this

finding is wrong. Consequently, finding no merit this appeal is dismissed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending C.Ms, if any, also stand disposed of.
