The petitioner is aggrieved by the action of respondent No.1 as in pursuance of the policy of the State Government of one time settlement, case of the petitioner is not being considered. Petitioner has made a detailed representation on 21.11.2017 (Annexure P-14) but no action has been taken so far.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Ms. Anu Chatrath, Addl. A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case directions are issued by this Court to consider the pending representation. Learned counsel also submits that he is ready to comply with all terms and conditions of the policy in case the action is taken by the respondent-authorities.

Keeping in view the limited prayer of the petitioner and without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to take action on the pending representation dated 21.11.2017 (Annexure P-14) and take action in accordance with the policy applicable and law within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order. In case personal appearance of the petitioner is required, the opportunity of hearing be given to him.
