The petitioner was dismissed from service on account of misconduct. However, in a departmental appeal preferred against his dismissal, the appellate authority i.e. respondent No.3, vide order Annexure P16, taking a sympathetic view, converted the order of dismissal to stoppage of 8 annual increments with cumulative effect. The petitioner purports to have preferred a revision (Annexure P17) against the order passed by the appellant authority, which is allegedly pending before respondent No.2. It is urged that respondent No.2 be directed to consider and decide his revision within a specified time.

That being so, the petition is disposed of, at this stage, only with a direction to respondent No.2 that, if indeed, any revision is pending against the order passed by the appellate authority (Annexure P16), the same be decided within a period of 3 months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.
