Mr. Siddharth Sanwaria, DAG, Haryana, present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents. Copies furnished.

For the nature of order I propose to pass in the matter, no formal written statements/counter affidavits on behalf of the respondents are indeed necessary, at this stage. Thus, with the consent of the parties, the petition is being disposed of finally.

The petitioner is aggrieved by a letter dated 13.02.2018 (Annexure P5), issued by respondent No.2, vide which the drawing and disbursing power of Government High School, Haibatpur, Block Bilaspur, District Yamuna Nagar has been assigned to TGT Rudresh Kumar (respondent No.4). The case of the petitioner is that respondent No.4 is way too junior to the petitioner and, therefore, the observation in the impugned

letter (Annexure P5) that he is the senior Master of the school is erroneous. Further, the same is also in breach of the Government instructions/circular dated 09.09.2016 (Annexure P6).

In response, learned State counsel submits that this petition itself shall be considered as representation on behalf of the petitioner, and the respondents shall deal with the grievance and claim of the petitioner within a period of 4 weeks from today. Appropriate orders, in accordance with law, shall be passed and communicated to the petitioner.

The petition is accordingly disposed of in the above terms.

Needless to assert that in the event the claim of the petitioner is declined, the respondent authority shall pass a comprehensive order assigning reasons in support thereof.
