Mr. Siddharth Sanwaria, DAG, Haryana, present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Copies furnished.

For the nature of order I propose to pass in the matter, no formal written statements/counter affidavits on behalf of the respondents are indeed necessary, at this stage. Thus, with the consent of the parties, the petition is being disposed of finally.

The petitioners pray for a direction to the respondents to release their salary which is due since July 2017, for, post their transfer from CHC Guhla, District Kaithal to District Rohtak, pursuant to an order dated 28.07.2017 (Annexure P1), they have not been paid anything. The petitioners purport to have repeatedly represented to the respondents in this regard. But to no avail. Even the representation dated 17.01.2018 (Annexure P8), the respondents have been served with, has failed to evoke any

response. Resultantly, the petitioners continue to suffer and are facing extreme financial crisis.

In response, learned State counsel submits that the claim of the petitioners, as also their representation dated 17.01.2018 (Annexure P8), shall be considered and dealt with within a period of 3 days from today. And appropriate orders, in accordance with law, shall be passed and communicated to the petitioners.

The petition is accordingly disposed of in the above terms.

Needless to assert that in the event the claim of the petitioners is declined, the respondent authority shall pass a comprehensive order assigning reasons in support thereof.

Further, if no order is passed by the respondents within the specified time, as indicated earlier, the petitioners shall be at liberty to move an appropriate application in this petition itself for its restoration and decision on merits.
