The petitioner had approached this Court questioning the notification (Annexure P-5) in particular, clause 8. This very notification had been challenged in the High Court of Delhi where the writ petition was accepted. During the course of hearing of the said writ petition in Delhi High Court, Medical Council of India on its own vide order dated 24.4.2018 issued a clarification regarding the eligibility of various categories of candidates who wish to appear in NEET-UG-2018. This writ petition was disposed of on the basis of the aforesaid clarification with a direction that
