Petitioner belongs to Mazhabi Sikh Caste (Punjab) and is challenging the advertisement dated 20.12.2017 (P-3) issued by the Punjab State Power Corporation Limited to the extent of post of Junior Engineers (Electrical) whereby no relaxation in percentage of marks in the basic/professional qualification i.e. Bachelor of Engineering have been given for the candidates belonging to the reserved category. The eligibility conditions, *inter alia*, prescribed are candidate must possess the Diploma Certificate with 60% marks or a Bachelor of Engineering with 50% for all categories.

After arguing for sometime, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the present petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
