The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to continue the old age pension as being paid to the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that earlier the petitioners were being paid pension but it was stopped. Thereafter again it was started but presently they are not being paid.

The petitioners should have approached the respondent-authorities first by way of moving representation but no such representation has been made and straightway the present petition has been filed for issuance of a writ of mandamus.

The petitioners are at liberty to make representation to the concerned authorities and in case no action is taken on the representation

then they are at liberty to approach this Court.

Dismissed as premature at this stage with the aforesaid liberty.
