This petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking direction to the respondent-authorities to provide adequate security and other basic amenities during fair (Mela), which is going to be organized w.e.f. 25.02.2018 to 28.02.2018.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that every year this fair (Mela) is held and on every occasion, people come in thousands. This time, the number of people is likely to be increased much more. Petitioner had made representation dated 30.01.2018 (Annexure P-3) to the Deputy Commissioner, Panipat as well as Superintendent of Police, Panipat, but no action has been taken so far. Learned counsel further submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case directions are issued by this Court to respondents No.2 and 3 to consider the pending representation within the stipulated period.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Anil Mehta, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Keeping in view the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner and without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition stands disposed of with a direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to consider representation dated 30.01.2018 (Annexure P-3) and take action in accordance with law.
