Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that so far as the payment of principal amount is concerned, this petition has become infructuous as the principal amount has been paid but it is alleged that the same has been paid after a period of five years, therefore, petitioner is entitled to interest also.

In view of the aforesaid, though the present petition is disposed of as infructuous but liberty is granted to the petitioner to make a representation to the respondents about the amount of component of interest. If such an application is filed within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, the respondents shall decide the same within a period of three months thereafter by giving due opportunity of hearing to the petitioner and by passing a speaking order.
