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The matter has again been discussed with the learned counsel for the parties, in detail and they have arrived at a settlement.

As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the appellant as well as counsel for the Insurance Company, separately recorded, a sum of Rs.1,60,000/- (Rupees One Lakh Sixty Thousand Only) over and above the amount already awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellant in full and final settlement of the claim. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellant, the enhanced amount be paid to the appellant No.1-Rekha Devi W/o Late Sh. Kuldeep Singh.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit cheque for Rs.1,60,000/- (Rupees One Lakh Sixty Thousand Only) favouring appellant No.1-Rekha Devi W/o Late Sh. Kuldeep Singh with the Office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 15.01.2019. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellant's counsel may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat after retaining the photocopy of the cheque/draft bearing signatures of the Counsel.

Appeal stands disposed of.
