The precise case of the petitioner-bank is that the borrower-respondent No.2 has filed a statutory appeal before the Debts Recovery Appellate Tribunal, New Delhi against the interlocutory order dated 21.01.2016 passed by the Debts Recovery Tribunal-II, Chandigarh. The grievance in the instant writ petition is that though more than two years have passed, learned Appellate Tribunal has not decided the above-stated appeal due to which the main case is not being taken up by the Debts Recovery Tribunal-II, Chandigarh. The appeal is now stated to be listed for hearing on 09.03.2018.

Having regard to the nature of relief sought and the period already spent in the pending appeal, the instant writ petition is disposed of with a request to the learned Presiding Officer of DRAT, New Delhi to take up and decide the above-mentioned appeal at the earliest and preferably on the date fixed, if so possible.
