The petitioner approached this Court claiming difference of arrears of subsistence allowance on reinstatement of service. The petitioner has been acquitted in FIR No. 12 dated 30.12.2014 by the judgment and order dated 14.07.2016 passed by the Special Court at Panchkula. The petitioner has filed several representations including the legal notice dated 25.12.2017 which have evoked no response from the authorities.

In the circumstances, the petition is disposed of with the direction to the competent authorities to decide the legal notice within six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order.

As far as the grievance regarding the reinstatement in service that no longer exists since order dated 28.03.2018 has been passed reinstating the petitioner subject to outcome of the appeal pending in this Court against the order of acquittal.

For the balance amount, the legal notice may be decided.
