This petition is filed for seeking direction to respondent No.2 to initiate action on the recommendations of the proforma respondent No.6 i.e. Punjab State Commission for NRIs, Chandigarh [for short 'the Commission'] in terms of the order passed by it on 13.10.2017.

I have heard learned counsel for petitioner and perused the record.

The Commission has made the following recommendations on 13.10.2017: -

"Thus, recommendation is made for registration of a case u/s 420 IPC, as recommended, vide report dated 05.05.2017 of AIG, NRI Wing, Ludhiana. Further, recommendation is also made to add the relevant offence under the provision of "The Punjab Prevention of Human Smuggling Act, 2012 against Rajinder Kaur, as in the

inquiry report, a conclusion has been reached by the IP that Rajinder Kaur, had hatched a criminal conspiracy to reach Canada by cheating the complainant under the garb of marriage.

Further recommendation is made to DGP, Punjab to examine the role of AIG, NRI Wing, Ludhiana, who submitted the report dated 26.8.2017, whereby original recommendations were diluted and take suitable action, in case such officers is found guilty.”

The grievance of the petitioner is that the said recommendations are not being implemented despite the fact that the representation was made to respondent No.2.

Be that as it may, the petitioner may approach the Commission again with a representation bringing to its notice that the recommendations made by it have not been complied with by the officer to whom direction was issued.
