On the asking of the Court, Mr. Hitesh Pandit, Additional A.G.
Haryana, present in court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

In the nature of order I propose to pass, no formal written
statement(s)/counter-affidavit(s) on behalf of the respondents are indeed
necessary at this stage. Thus, with the consent of the parties, the petition is
being finally disposed of.

The petitioner is engaged as a part-time Sweeper with the
respondent department and is posted at 132 KV Sub Station, Assandh, since
April, 1996. Although he has rendered 21 years of continuous service, but
his claim for regularisation of service has not been considered. He prays for
a direction to the respondents to consider his claim, in terms of the
government policy dated 29.7.2011 (Annexure P-1). The petitioner purports
to have even served the respondents with a legal notice dated 12.10.2017
(Annexure P-5). But to no avail.

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In response, learned State counsel submits that the claim/grievance of the petitioner as also his legal notice, dated 12.10.2017 (Annexure P-5), shall be considered and dealt with within a period four weeks from today. And appropriate orders, in accordance with law, shall be passed and communicated to the petitioner.

The petition is accordingly disposed of, in the above terms. However, in the event the claim of the petitioner is declined, the respondent authorities shall pass a comprehensive order assigning reasons in support thereof. If no orders are passed within the specified time, as indicated above, the petitioner shall have the liberty to move an appropriate application in this petition itself for restoration and decision on merits.
