JASWANT SINGH, J.(ORAL)

The petitioner is working as JBT Teacher since 23.10.1998. He is stated to have acquired Bachelor of Education (B.Ed) degree from Punjab University in the examination held in November 2008, thereby became eligible for promotion to the post of Social Studies Master governed under the Punjab State Education Class-III (School Cadre) Service Rules, 1978.

The grievance of the Petitioner is that her case for promotion was sent in 2008-09 and thereafter again on 10.11.2015 by the District Education Officer, Amritsar, however, no intimation was received regarding the fate of such consideration.

This Court had directed the State Counsel to verify the facts in the light of the contents of the letter dated 3.11.2017 (P-11) acknowledging the aforesaid facts.

instructions from Mr. Amandeep Singh, Senior Assistant, office of DPI (SE), Punjab Mohali states that the cases of those ETT teachers were considered for promotion to the rank of Social Studies Master in the year 2008-09 who had acquired the prescribed essential qualifications by 30.08.2008. Since the petitioner has acquired the qualification of B.Ed in November 2008, therefore, was not entitled for consideration for promotion, therefore, the contents of P-11 stands explained.

In view of the aforesaid, no case is made out for interference, however, if the aforesaid factual position is incorrect, the petitioner would seek his remedy to revive the present writ petition within a period of two months from today.

Dismissed in aforesaid terms.
