The Union of India has challenged the order dated 27.10.2017 (Annexure P-3) in above three Civil Writ Petitions bearing Nos.4350 and 4374 of 2018, under Article 226/227 of Constitution of India, whereby respondent No.1 has allowed the application under Section 28-A of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 and granted enhanced compensation at the rate of Rs.2300/- per marla.
