DEEPAK SIBAL, J. (ORAL)

The present appeal has been preferred by the appellants/claimants seeking enhancement in the compensation granted to them through the award dated 04.01.2016, passed by the Motor Accident Claims Tribunal, Yamuna Nagar at Jagadhri (for short, the Tribunal). Such compensation was granted to them on a claim petition filed by them under Section 166 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 on account of the death of their son-Pardeep Kumar in a motor vehicular accident which took place on 03.06.2013 at about 10:30 PM, near Aggarsen Chowk, Jagadhri.

At the very outset, Ms. Vandana Malhotra, Advocate, appearing on behalf of respondent No. 3-Insurance Company submits that she has express instructions from her client that it is willing to pay to appellant No. 1 an amount of ₹2,50,000/- over and above the compensation granted through the award under challenge as full and final settlement to the appellants qua the accident in question.

Learned counsel for the appellants/claimants submits that his clients are willing to accept the above offer as full and final settlement of their claims.

In view of the above consensus between the parties to which they are directed to remain bound, the present appeal is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 3-Insurance Company to deposit within six weeks from today a demand draft for a sum of ₹2,50,000/- in favour of respondent No. 1 before the Lok Adalat Branch of this Court for onward disbursement of the same to appellant No. 1.
