Through the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of a writ particularly in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to clear the arrears of pension of the petitioner along with interest as per the chart given by the petitioner on 19.01.2017 (P-5).

2. Previously, petitioner preferred the CWP No.27848 of 2013, captioned as ***Sher Singh vs. State of Haryana and ors.***, which was disposed of vide order dated January 24, 2017 (P-8) with the following order:-

“This petition has been preferred for issuance of direction to respondents to pay interest @ 18% per annum on all the delayed payments of salary on account of revised pay and revised pay scales, pension and other retiral benefits to the petitioner.

Learned State counsel has stated that pursuant to the order dated 20.10.2016, passed by this Court entire payment

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has been made. Further, he has fairly stated that the petitioner can come to the office and reconcile the differences.

In these circumstances, the instant petition stands disposed of.”

3. In pursuance of the aforesaid order, petitioner approached the respondents and moved representations dated 23.02.2017, 27.02.2017, 09.03.2017 and 15.03.2017 but till date no final decision has been taken. The respondents have only calculated the interest to the tune of Rs.13,247/-, whereas it works out to approximately more than Rs.3 lacs.

4. Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents to reconsider the matter with regard to interest granted to the petitioner and take a conscious decision within a period of two months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.
