The petitioner was selected as C&V Teacher (Sanskrit) under the Scheduled Caste Category. Accordingly, a letter of appointment dated 11.08.2004, was issued to the petitioner by the Education Officer Faridabad, and he consequently joined service on 12.08.2004. The limited grievance that the petitioner has is; that one Mahender Singh (respondent No.3), who happened to be junior to the petitioner, was promoted to the post of Elementary School Headmaster, therefore, the petitioner too is required to be considered for promotion from the same date. The petitioner purports to have repeatedly represented to the respondents in this regard. But to no avail. Even the legal notice dated 03.11.2017 (Annexure P11), the respondents have been served with, has failed to evoke any response.

That being so, the petition is disposed of, at this stage, only with a direction to the respondents to consider and decide the claim of the petitioner, as also his representation dated 03.11.2017 (Annexure P11), within a period of 3 months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.

And pass appropriate orders in accordance with law. Needless to assert that in the event the claim of the petitioner is declined, the respondent authority shall pass a comprehensive order assigning reasons in support thereof.
