Mr. Gaurav Jindal, Addl. AG, Haryana, present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. Copies furnished.

For the nature of order I propose to pass in the matter, no formal written statements/counter affidavits on behalf of the respondents are indeed necessary, at this stage. Thus, with the consent of the parties, the petition is being disposed of finally.

The petitioners are engaged as part-time Sweepers with the respondent-department, and are posted at Hydel Project, HPGCL, Budhkalan since 01.01.1986 and 01.12.1987, respectively. Although, they have rendered over 30 years of continuous service, but their claim for regularization of service has not been considered. Thus, a direction is prayed for to the respondents to consider their claim, in terms of the Government Policy dated 29.07.2011 (Annexure P1). The petitioners purport to have

even served the respondents with a legal notice dated 15.10.2017 (Annexure P4). But to no avail.

In response, learned State counsel submits that the claim/grievance of the petitioners, as also their legal notice dated 15.10.2017 (Annexure P4), shall be considered and dealt with within a period of four weeks from today. And appropriate orders, in accordance with law, shall be passed and communicated to the petitioners.

The petition is accordingly disposed of in the above terms. However, in the event the claim of the petitioners is declined, the respondent-authorities shall pass a comprehensive order assigning reasons in support thereof.
