Through the instant civil writ petition, preferred under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, petitioner has sought the issuance of a writ especially in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to regularize the services of the petitioner from the date his junior have been regularized i.e. under the instructions dated 31.12.1998/25.02.1999 (P-5 colly) w.e.f. 01.03.1999 and further to grant all consequential benefits i.e. Pay fixation, seniority, arrears of salary from the said date and further to allot GPF account number to him for subscription of General Provident Fund and to grant pension and arrears along with interest @ 18% per annum.

2. At the very outset of the arguments, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that she feel satisfied in case a direction is issued to

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respondents No.2 & 3 to decide the legal notice dated April 25, 2017 (P-8) in a time bound manner.

3. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents No.2 & 3 to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in the aforesaid legal notice dated April 25, 2017 (P-8) and to take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case, non compliance of this order, petitioner shall be at liberty to approach this Court.
