The complaint that the petitioners are being paid wages less than the minimum wages fixed under the Act by the appropriate Government/Deputy Commissioners, the petitioners have an alternative remedy under Section 20 of the Minimum Wages Act, 1948.

Regarding this, the petition is dismissed with the aforesaid liberty.

As far as claim for regularization is concerned that claim the petitioners may pursue with the respondent-Department.

A legal notice has been served by the petitioners which will be looked into and decided by the competent authority within reasonable time of say three months. If hearing is found necessary, then the petitioners or their representatives can be called to express their views before decision is taken.
